JT brings global event to the eyes of the world through industry leading connectivity

Jersey based digital media company Senergy Digital have secured a partnership with the tourism marketing office, Visit Jersey to promote the event and JT, the Island's primary telecoms operator, to deliver first-class digital streaming of the 2016 Bloch Dance World Cup to a worldwide audience.

The online service, free-to-view, will be available on any device. Additional video content will document the incredible excitement of the event and will be broadcast on the stream and through social media channels.

Huge demand for the service is expected following excellent results from the Dance World Cup held in Romania last year, which saw over 3 million streaming minutes watched in 92 countries through the course of the 7 day event; over 420,000 individual views.

Bloch Dance World Cup, a prestigious dance competition expects over 3,000 competitors from 41 countries to perform in Jersey during the week long contest, starting June 25th.

Visit Jersey's support for the live stream comes at the same time as the launch of their new brand for Jersey, which presents an exciting new vision for the marketing of the island.

This also coincides with the 2016 launch of the Dance World Cup online members platform 'Club Wow', tailor made by Senergy to bring the dance community together. 'Club Wow' provides competitors with members-only access to event photographs and video-on-demand. Users of the live stream and Club Wow platform will be greeted in advance with intelligently tailored Visit Jersey promotional content. Visit Jersey will then stay connected with the 3,000+ competitors and the global live stream audience through digital and social media remarketing campaigns.
